

# Fenderboard template

Convert your old Dyfi Events numberboards into a simple MTB fender using our template.

## DIRECTIONS

1. Cut out the template and Poke holes through the centre of each marked hole position in the template with something sharp.
2. Transfer the shape to the back of your old number board, then trace round the outline using a marker pen.
3. Mark the position of the holes using the marker pen.
4. Cut out the shape using a sharp pair of scissors.

**TIP:** Before making the fender arch holes its a good idea to try offering up the template to your bike to see if these holes are in a good position. If not, mark suitable locations and punch them there.

5. Make the holes using one of the methods suggested on [dyfievents.com/fender](http://dyfievents.com/fender)
5. Use cable ties to fit the fender to your bike then go shred!

## IMPORTANT

You'll need to tell your printer to "PRINT ACTUAL SIZE" or it might get scaled smaller to fit inside the print area of the A4 sheet. This might clip the edges off the template depending on how wide your printers print area is but you can easily draw in the missing bit if this happens.
